This annual event brings together individuals who support NCWU member organizations and others who share our goals to visit the legislature. Member organizations provide specific bill numbers and talking points which the individuals can use in their discussions with their representatives. NCWU also provides training for those who may want some guidelines on how to talk to a legislator. Each legislator, whether or not one of their constituents attends the day, will get a packet of information, and a press conference will highlight the agenda for the media.
